This position, when coupled with starter and outside operations responsibilities, is one that presents unique opportunities to provide exceptional service and will require a candidate that works well with others and one that can multitask in a fast-paced environment with minimal supervision.

Responsibilities:

Caddie Manager

- Practice and promote name recognition.
- * Works with Jonas tee sheet, ClubUp and Assistant Caddie Master to schedule caddie loops.
- * Communicate with caddies to ensure that they are with their loops on the practice tee prior to their round.
- Proactively communicate with membership, guests, and co-workers to provide appropriate and timely caddie assessment.
- Caddie Training promote excellent habits through rigorous training program of young, incoming caddies.
- Work with Assistant Caddie Master to orchestrate caddie payroll weekly.
- Roaring Fork Club has a proud tradition of sending student and honor caddies through the Evans Scholar Program. This position will have a working knowledge of this program and be able to promote and assist eligible caddies through this process.
- Monitor pace of play and act as on course player assistant when needed.
- Play golf with members, when desired, to promote the caddie program and its ideals.

Starter

- **Responsibilities:** Control first tee and practice tee flow and reporting of all players to the first tee.
 - Inform players of the Rules of Play of the Roaring Fork Club.
 - Daily: Cart usage, GPS usage, beverage cart/food options, inform players/members of the pace of play of Roaring Fork Club, assist players with determining the appropriate tees for their play
 - Thoroughly understand the golf operation: Professional Shop, Practice Facility, outside operations, tournament schedule, golf instructional staff
 - Effectively communicate and coordinate with all members of the golf staff.
 - Identify policy issues and alert the professional staff.
 - Check in all players and record transportation details.
 - Possess the ability to mentally and physically organize the first tee to coordinate a smooth transition for the members from the practice areas to the first tee.
 - Communicate with co-workers, members, and caddies to maintain a smooth flow of traffic on the golf course.
 - Process guest fees, cart fees and other transactions using Jonas point of sale system.
 - Assist the professional staff with tournaments and special events as required.
 - Look for opportunities to create memorable and unique experiences for our membership and their guests.

Requirements:

- High degree of professionalism and commitment to excellence and high standards in customer service.
- Communication skills to work with caddies and members to understand the desire of a consistent and high quality product.
- An understanding of golf course flow and operations is critical to ensure on time operations at a busy seasonal club.
- Detail-oriented and able to prioritize workload, managing multiple tasks simultaneously in a fast-paced working environment with limited supervision.
- Track record of planning and organizing people and projects.
- Ability to be a self-starter whereby little supervision is required to accomplish tasks.
